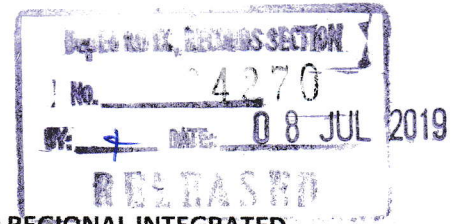

SUBJECT: IDENTIFICATION OF PROSPECTIVE LGU-BIDDERS TO HOST 2019 REGIONAL INTEGRATED
COMPETITION

DATE: July 4, 2019



The 2019 Regional Integrated Competition (RIC), the region's premier annual schools integrated competition participated by elementary and secondary pupils-students, coaches, officiating officials, and other members of the delegation from the 8 divisions.

In view of this, the Department of Education (DepEd) Region IX encourages the Schools Division Superintendents to coordinate with their local government unit (LGUs) in submitting their bid proposal if willing to host the aforementioned competition.

Determination of prospective LGU-bidders shall be based on their capability and readiness to host the 2019 RIC that is scheduled on December 1 – 4, 2019. Specifically, the LGU-bidder should observe the following criteria:

- a. The contest venues to be used are accessible and free to the general public, well-secured, ready to be used, and are of international standards for sports;
- b. The billeting areas for the athletic delegations and technical officials are provided with sufficient and adequate sleeping quarters, comfort rooms, wash areas, kitchen and dining areas;
- c. The playing/contest venues and billeting areas capability to provide the basic services such as medical and dental, communication, adequate water supply, and uninterrupted electric power supply;
- d. The peace and order situation in the locality must be excellent and conducive to staging a regional activity;
- e. Capability and willingness of the LGU to shoulder expenses necessary for the hosting of the 2019 RIC, including construction and renovation of sports facilities, contest venues, billeting areas, and other infrastructure requirements; and
- f. The manifestation of uncompromising unity of all socio-economic political groups, government, and non-government entities in the locality in ensuring the successful conduct of the 2019 RIC.

The division office shall submit the letter of intent of prospective LGU-bidders to the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) on or before **July 22, 2019**. Presentation of LGU-bidders shall be on **July 26, 2019** during the 6th Regional Management Committee Meeting.

Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

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
