- a. Concurrence with LGU (Barangay, City/Municipality/Province),
 - b. Ensure seventy (70 % or above) vaccination rate/herd immunity among teaching and non-teaching personnel,
 - c. Implementation plan following the four components of the operational framework, namely:
(i) Safe Operations, (ii) Teaching and Learning, (iii) Well-being and Protection and (iv) Home-School Coordination,
 - d. Contingency plan showing action points to address contingencies during its implementation.
5. This office shall likewise conduct a rigorous monitoring and evaluation of all identified schools to provide indication on further improvements or adjustments needed to raise the level of readiness and ensure its smooth implementation.
6. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
